Mrs. Bettylu Ann Lonergan, age 78, passed away Thursday, March 28, 2013 in Grand Haven. Mrs. Lonergan was born February 11, 1935 to William C. and Helen (Seastrand) Lauterberg in Muskegon and was a life resident of the area. She was employed as a payroll clerk at Sealed Power Corporation for 31 years, retiring in 2000. Bettylu was a former member of Crestwood United Methodist Church and is a current member of McGraft Memorial Congregational Church. She married Kenneth Lonergan on November 27, 1954, and he preceded her in death in 1989. 


