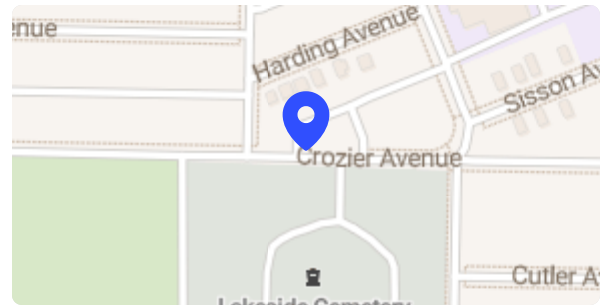
JUN 28, 1961 - JUN 2, 2013

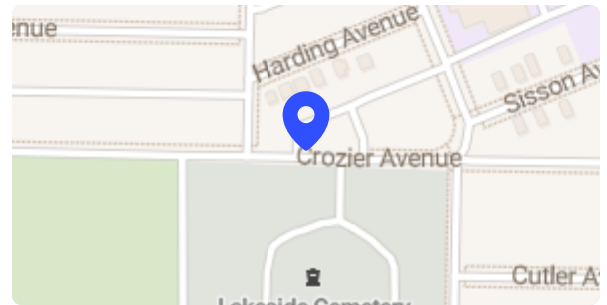
