SEP 29, 1928 - JUL 24, 2013

In the early morning hours of July 24, 2013, Ramona Jeanne (Clark) Wilder took the hands of Jesus and her beloved husband, George "Brub" Wilder, and entered her heavenly home. She was born September 29, 1928 in Muskegon to Roscoe and Beatrice (Cobb) Clark and had been a life resident. Ramona worked for the Oakridge School system as a cook for 6 years before retiring. She was a very active member of Fellowship Reformed Church, where she belonged to the Ladies Aide, Mission Guild, bible study, and was co-chair for funeral luncheons. She liked to read, crochet, visit with church shut-ins, was a Hospice sewing volunteer, made quilts for the Grand Rapids Cancer Center, local veterans in Muskegon, nursing homes, and those in need within the church. She also belonged to the Bunco Club and the Oakridge Golden Eagle Senior Center. In 1948 she married George D. Wilder in Muskegon at St. Paul's Lutheran Church and he preceded her in death on December 8, 1994. SURVIVORS include 4 sons, George (Betty) Wilder of Florida, Roger (Marti) Wilder of Grand Haven, Richard (Terri) Wilder, Randy (Vanessa) Wilder both of Muskegon; 15 grandchildren; 32 great-grandchildren; and a sister, Yvonne (Joe) Phinney of Clare, MI; and a multitude of nieces and nephews. She was also preceded in death by her parents; brother, Roscoe Clark, Jr. and sisters, Beverly and Elva. The joys in her life were her family, her friends, and her church. 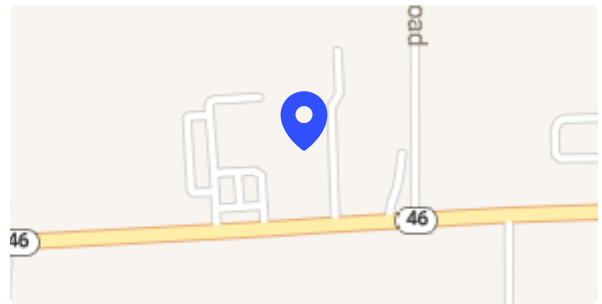

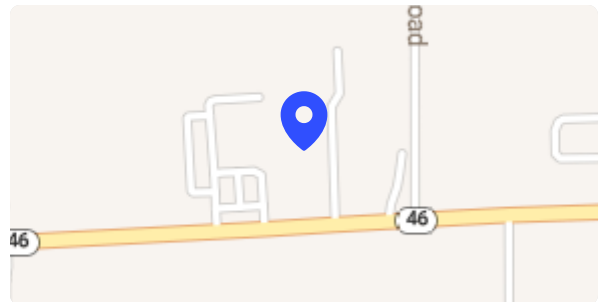
