**R**andolph "Randy" Lee Rymal, age 59, of Grand Haven passed away Saturday, February 8, 2014, at Heartwood Lodge Hospice Residence. He was born April 17, 1954 in Grand Haven to Floyd and Mary (Kinser) Rymal.

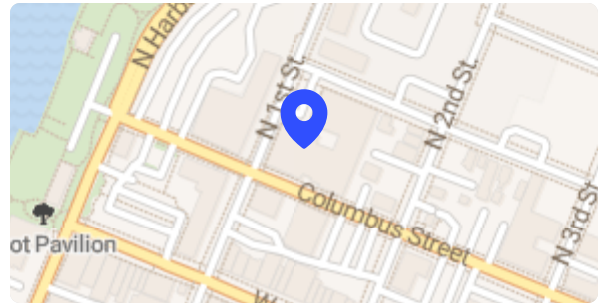

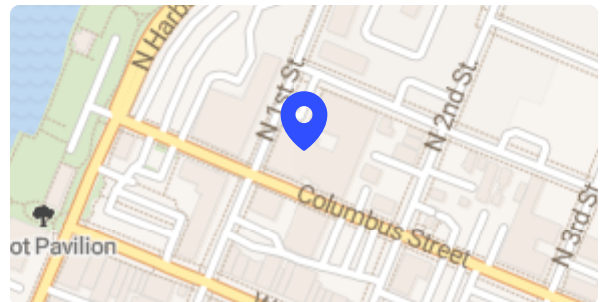
