Mr. Daniel M. Fullmer, Jr., age 73, passed away Thursday, March 13, 2014 at his home. He was born on April 6, 1940 in Lansing, MI to Daniel and Ruth (Berger) Fullmer, Sr., and moved to the Muskegon area in 1976. Dan worked as an electrician for Kaydon, Sealed Power, and Wirtz Electric before retiring in 2003. He was a Veteran of the U.S. Navy Reserves having served during Desert Storm, and a member of VFW Post 446 in Muskegon. Dan was also a member of Evanston Ave. Baptist Church. On October 7, 1961, he married the former Cheryl J. Williamson, and she preceded him in death on September 19, 2013. 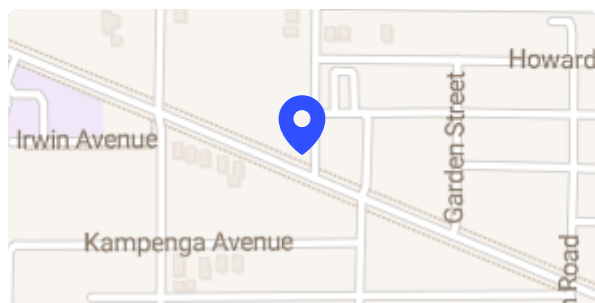

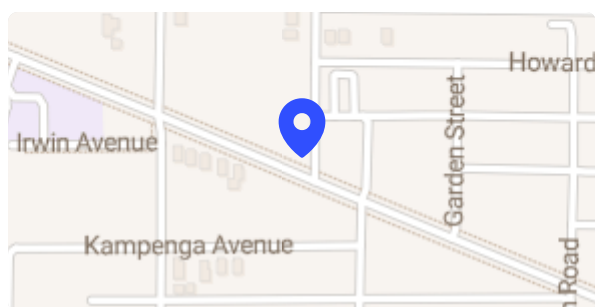

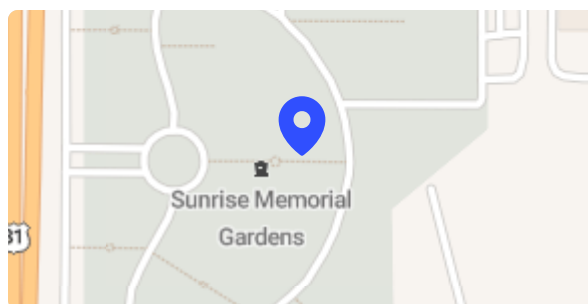
