Mr. Fred Powlenko, 89, passed away Saturday afternoon, July 12, 2014 in Muskegon. Fred was born November 11, 1924 to John Z. and Katherine (Szpieg) Powlenko in Muskegon, and was a lifelong resident. He worked at Sealed Power for 33 years before retiring, and was a member of Central United Methodist Church. He belonged to the Masons, danced in the Ukranian group in New York City, performed in many plays with the Civic Opera, and had been the area and district governor of the Toastmasters. On February 27, 1965 Fred married Patricia J. Steenhagen. 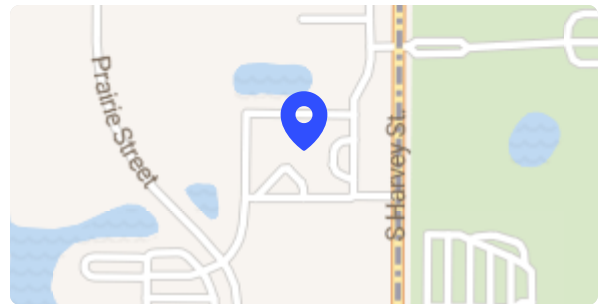

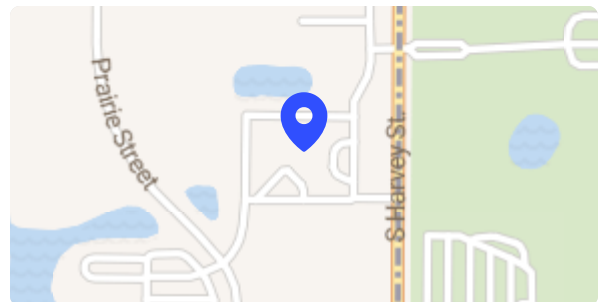

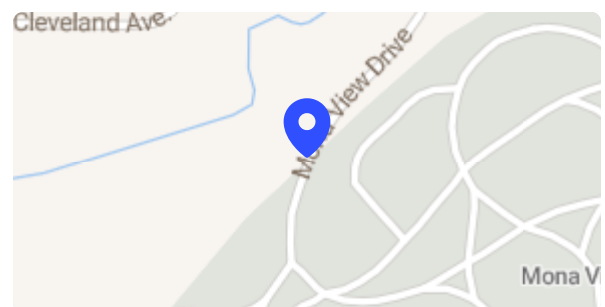
