## Frances Mary Kolenic

MAR 9, 1925 - JUL 28, 2014

**M**rs. Frances Mary Kolenic, age 89, passed away on Monday, July 28, 2014 in Muskegon. She was born on March 9, 1925 in Grand Rapids to Anthony and Martha (Narloch) Kulesza, and resided in Muskegon her entire life. She worked in the office at Norge prior to working at Cherokee Restaurant for many years. Fran enjoyed reading, scary movies, and long summer afternoons sitting on the deck with her grand-dog, Dixie. She loved a good meal, especially her favorite: a very rare steak and a White Russian (“a little less white and a little more Russian”). Fran will be remembered for her sharp sense of humor, big heart for animals and great love for her family. On October 7, 1950, she married Anthony Kolenic and he preceded her in death in 1971. SURVIVORS include 2 children, Tony (Maggie) Kolenic of Norton Shores and Ann Marie (Brian) Carter of Muskegon; 2 grandchildren, Bethany (Erin) Clark and Tony (Giselle) Kolenic; great grandson, Simon; and brother, Hank (Gwen) Kulesa of Kalamazoo. 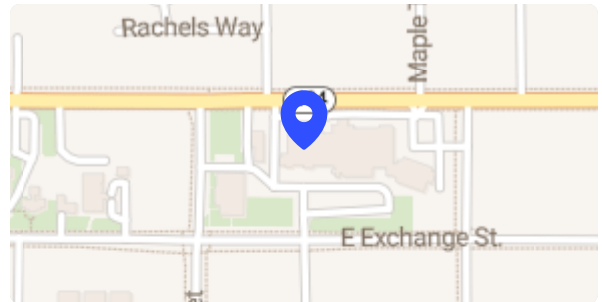

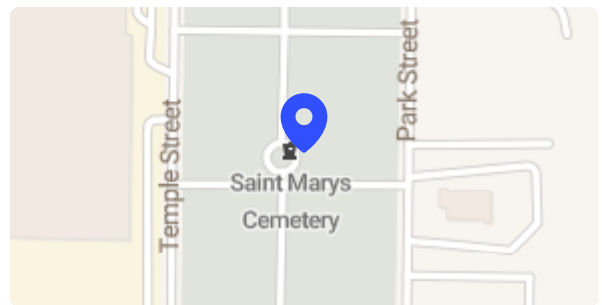
