Mrs. Geneva Bush, 100, went to be with her Lord Friday, August 1, 2014. Born May 16, 1914 to Bert and Carrie (Noordhof) Bolthouse, she was a life resident of Muskegon. Geneva married John Bush on June 1, 1945 in Muskegon, and he died February 27, 1984. She was a member of Bethany Christian Reformed Church and its Ladies Fellowship. She had worked as a stenographer for West Shore Mental Health for many years before retiring. Her SURVIVORS include her children: Karen (Dale) Carlson of Spring Lake, and David (Janis) Bush of Muskegon; four grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren.
