Mrs. Donna E. Holstine, age 94, passed away early Thanksgiving morning, November 27, 2014 after a short illness. She was born on September 26, 1920 to John and Bessie (Bowen) Veeneman. She resided in Muskegon all her life with the last 50 years a proud resident of Roosevelt Park. In August of 1937 she married Roland Holstine. Donna was employed by Sealed Power Corp. for 34 years as an inspector before retiring in 1981. 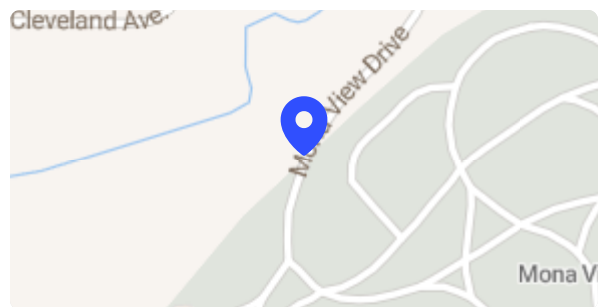
