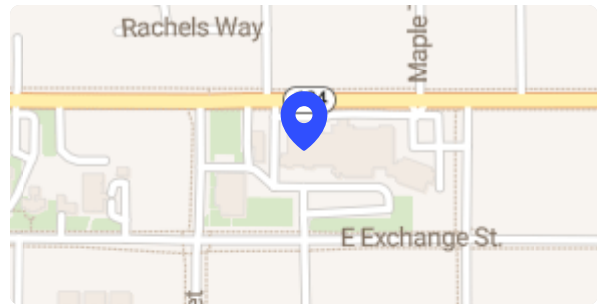
JAN 9, 1965 - DEC 9, 2014

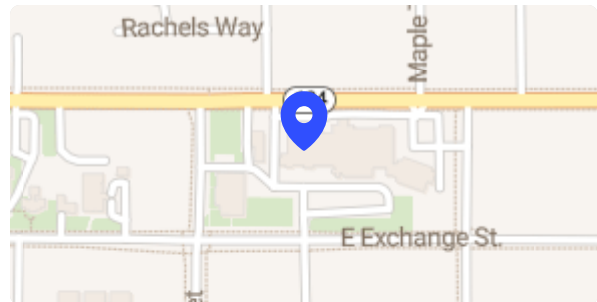

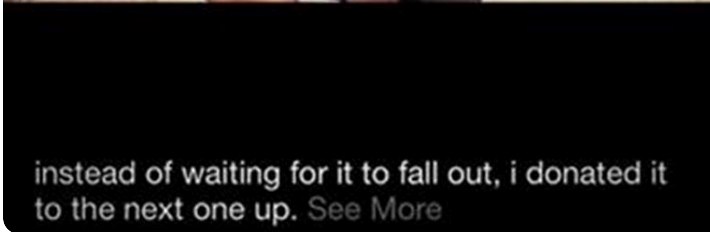
