Mrs. Isabelle Elizabeth Huddlestun, age 91, died Sunday morning, February 1, 2015 at her home. She was born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1923 in Custer, MI to McKinley and Viola (Davis) McClellan; and has resided in the Muskegon area since 1941. Isabelle was an active homemaker, having served as a past board member for Angell and Roosevelt Schools, was a past PTA participant, Den-mother for Boy Scouts, a Girl Scout Leader and was Past President of the "Blue Star Mothers". She was a member of Allen Avenue Christian Reformed Church. Isabelle was also a writer for Senior Perspectives through Tanglewood; and was a world traveler, especially enjoying New York, San Diego, Hawaii and Mexico, which she liked best. On November 15, 1941 she married Monroe F. Huddlestun and he preceded her in death on February 21, 1991. She was also preceded in death by her parents; son, Wayne; daughter, Sandra Bickford and by 2 brothers, Richard and Donald McClellan. 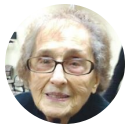
