Mrs. Darlene Mae Boucher, age 76, passed away Monday, June 1, 2015 in Grand Haven. Mrs. Boucher was born May 14, 1939 to Charles C. and Lilian E. (Dahl) Stark, Sr. in Muskegon. On June 29, 1961 she married Louis M. Boucher. She has been a member of Dr. Martin Luther Evangelical Lutheran Church since 1965, where she had served as a Sunday School teacher, sang in the choir, and was part of the Women's Fellowship. Darlene was all about family; early on, she was a Cub Scout Den leader, and loved spending time with her husband, children, and grandchildren. She also loved traveling and walking the boardwalk, or just being at the beach. Darlene enjoyed her time as a teacher's aide for Hile and Ross Park Elementary Schools, where she was employed for almost 27 years. 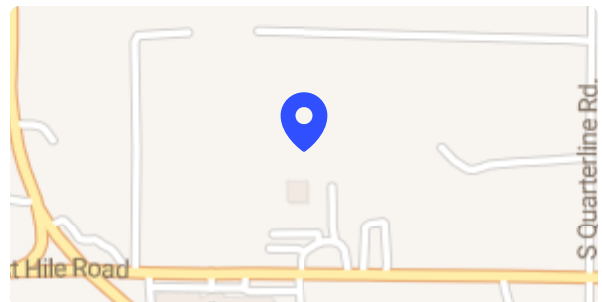

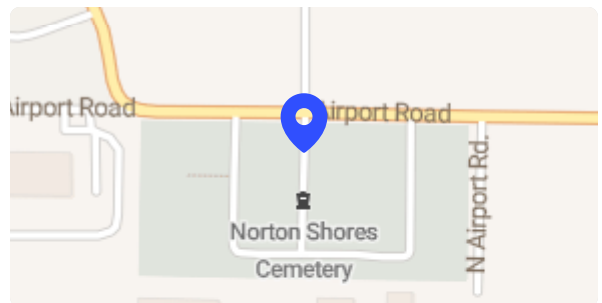
