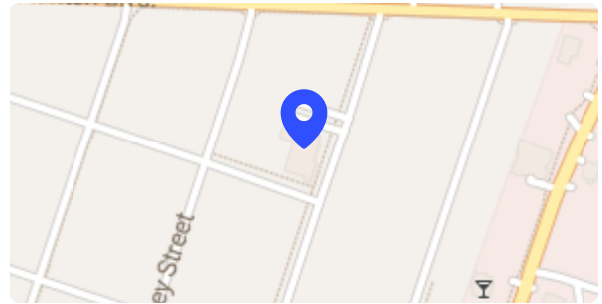
NOV 25, 1925 - SEP 14, 2015

Oswald "Oz" Hager, age 89, of Whitehall, left this world in the arms of Jesus on Monday, September 14, 2015. He was born November 25, 1925 in Muskegon to Otto and Marie (Kucklei) Hager. Oz graduated college with a Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry and Math from Western Michigan University. On July 31, 1948 he married Betty Livingston in Muskegon. He worked 27 years for Bofors Nobel, Inc. as a research chemist before retiring in 1991 and following retirement consulted for DSC Laboratories. Mr. Hager was a member of St. James Lutheran Church. He enjoyed making memories with family and friends, but most of all, he adored his granddaughters. 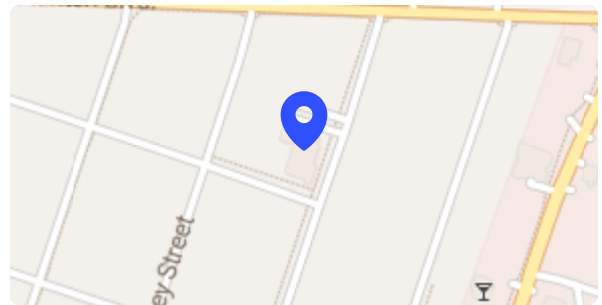

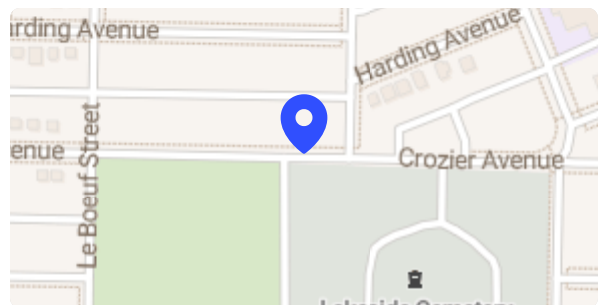
