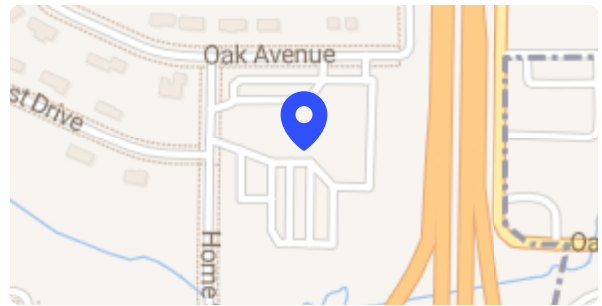

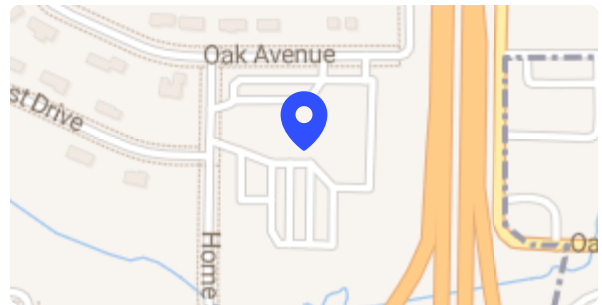

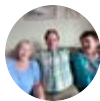


**John Huettner** sent a virtual gift in honor of Henry.
