**M**r. John VanRandwyk, age 89, went to be with his Lord, Thursday, February 25, 2016. He was born in Muskegon on June 23, 1926 to Henry and Dora (Duiser) VanRandwyk. John grew up on a farm between Kent City and Grant for 18 years after which he served 2 years in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He was employed with Bursma Radio Supply Company for the majority of his career. John was a member of Fruitport Christian Reformed Church, and he served on various boards for Kingdom causes. John married Henrietta "Etta" Holtrop on June 18, 1948, and together spent 64 years together before Etta preceded him in death on January 28, 2012.
