Mr. Harold J. "Stub" Cross, age 81, passed away Thursday, March 18, 2004 in Muskegon. He was born April 29, 1922 to Clifford and Ora Bell (Eaton) Cross in Muskegon and was a life resident. Mr. Cross was a veteran of the United States Army Air Force and had served in WWII. He was a machinist at The Norge and Sheldons before retiring from Security Steel. Stub was a professional musician and played in different country and polka variety bands. He was a member of the Muskegon Eagles and enjoyed baseball and fishing. On June 7, 1947 in Muskegon, he married Virginia M. 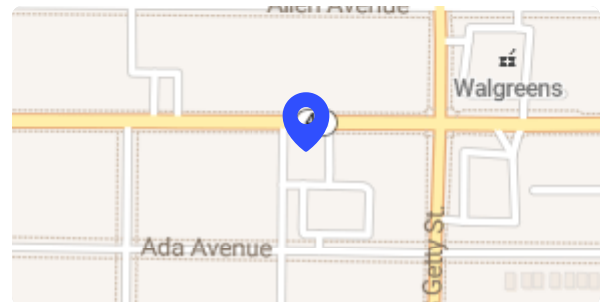
