Mr. Raymond R. Miller, Sr., age 77, died Monday morning May 24, 2004. He was born February 8, 1927 in Muskegon to Ray and Ora Belle (Derby) Miller, and had been a life resident. 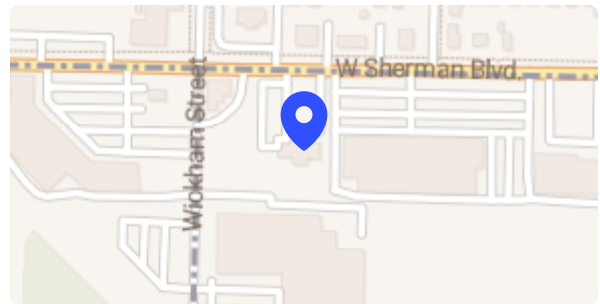

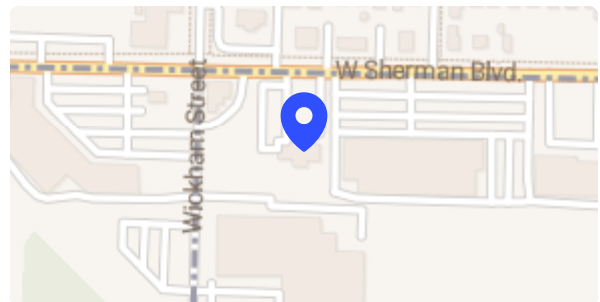
