Mrs. Mae J. Palsrok, age 92, passed away Monday evening, September 13, 2004 in St. Joseph, MI. She was born October 10, 1911 in Reeman, and lived almost all of her life in Muskegon, before moving to St. Joseph. She worked as a seamstress for Angie's Fashions for 18 years, retiring in 1994 at the age of 82, was a long-time member of First Christian Reformed Church, the Ladies Aid Society, and helped for many years with banquets at the Christian School. She married Peter Palsrok on October 10, 1934 in Reeman, and he preceded her in death on April 5, 1964. She was also preceded in death by 1 brother, and 7 sisters. 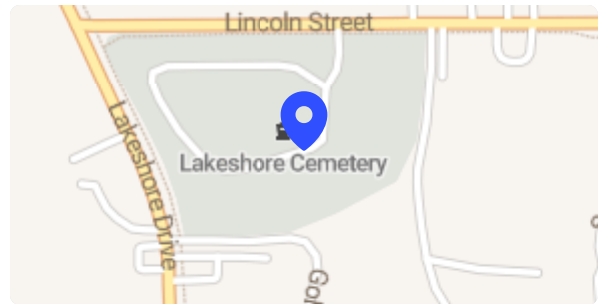
