Mr. Elmer Ernest Emmons, Sr., age 89, passed away Monday, September 20, 2004 at his home. Mr. Emmons was born September 18, 1915 to Ernest H. and Eunice (Hively) Emmons in Thompsonville, MI. On March 8, 1937, he married the former Sophie Ann Buway in Muskegon. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Muskegon and St. Vincent's Catholic Church in Pentwater. Mr. Emmons was the owner and operator of Emmons Construction Co. for 34 years, retiring in 1984. He took great pride in his trade and especially helping his children with their personal building projects. Elmer enjoyed fishing, hunting and attending family activities. 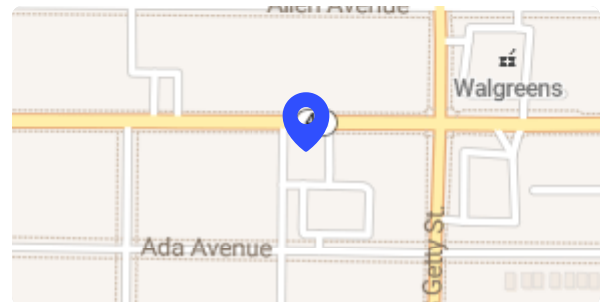
