She was born October 20, 1944 in Muskegon to Anthony and Amelia (Schmitt) Krywicki and lived her entire life in the area. On November 14, 1964, she married Jack A. Wortelboer in Brunswick. Gerri operated an adult foster care from her home from 1978 to 1994 and was the owner and operator of Tasty Corner Ice Cream Shop in Twin Lake from 1992 to the present. She was a member of Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Shelby and was a charter member of the VFW #3734 Auxiliary. 


