Alice M. Youngs, age 75, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 9th, at Muskegon's HVNS Hospice after a courageous struggle with cancer. Born to Sidney and Agnes (Miller) Campbell on December 18, 1929, her childhood and teen years were spent in the Ionia County area. She married William R. Youngs on April 3, 1948, and they raised two daughters. The family lived, for many years each, in the Michigan communities of Ionia, Battle Creek and, since 1977, in Muskegon. Alice was employed as a seamstress in Ionia, a patient care aide at Ft. Custer Hospital in Battle Creek, and an employee of the Secretary of State office in Battle Creek. Alice, tiny but feisty, was a devoted wife, mother and homemaker with an indomitable spirit, fierce loyalty to her family and a ready sense of humor. Her generosity, warmth and hospitality were extended to everyone she met. She was preceded in death by both of her parents and her eldest brother, Max Campbell of Saranac. Alice is survived by her husband, William R.
