Mrs. Ida Vanderlaan, age 93, passed away Tuesday morning, April 5, 2005. She was born July 11, 1911 in Muskegon to Louis and Anna (Achterhoff) Doorn, and had been a life resident of the area. Mrs. Vanderlaan was a member of Unity Reformed Church, where she had been a Sunday school teacher, a member of the Lois Circle and Cross Group, and belonged to Reformed Church Women's Ministries. On November 7, 1935, she married William "Bill" Vanderlaan in Muskegon, and he preceded her in death on February 4, 1992.
