Mrs. Mae Elizabeth Liefer, age 99, passed away Monday, August 29, 2005 at a local nursing home. 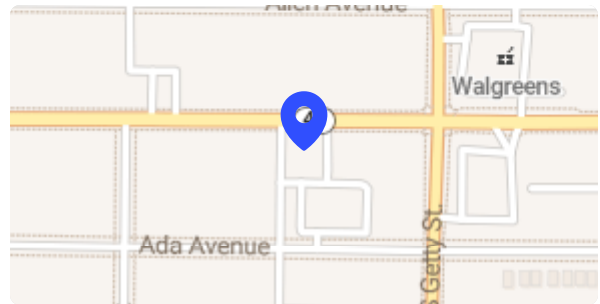
