**M**r. Donald K. Brooks, Sr., age 77, died early Sunday morning, September 4, 2005. He was born April 9, 1928 in Muskegon to Harold and Eva (Marsden) Brooks. At age 16, he enlisted with the Merchant Marines, where he served on a ship. He then enlisted with the U.S. Air Force. Mr. Brooks belonged to the Coast Guard Auxiliary and the Holton American Legion Post 397. He was retired as a certified mechanic from Duer Chevrolet in Fremont. On March 17, 1959, he married the former Leonor Morris, and she survives him along with 7 children, Donald Brooks, Jr of Canton, OK, Teresa (Bob) Klatt of Mohall, ND, Johnnie Boughner of Mt. Pleasant, MI, Sylvia Morsel of Denver, CO, Roger (Stephanie) Brooks, Brian Brooks both of Twin Lake, Melonie (Fred) Arbogast of Holton; 18 grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; 2 sisters, Lois (Laverne) Medendorp of Twin Lake, Linda Bonebrake of Muskegon; sister-in-law, Laura Brooks of Muskegon; and many nieces and nephews. 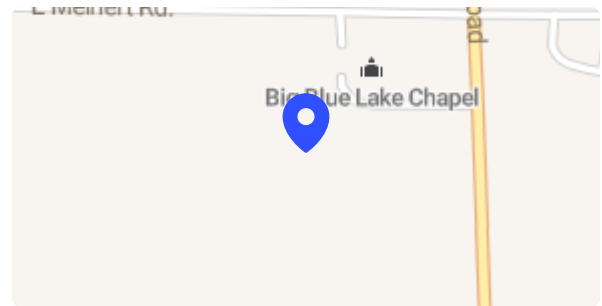
