Mrs. Anna "Ann" Laubach, age 90, passed away early Wednesday, December 14, 2005 in Running Springs, CA. She was born on August 11, 1915 to Simon and Mary (Rille) Westimayer in Beaver Dam, WI and lived in the Muskegon area for almost 60 years.
