JUL 24, 1913 - MAY 31, 2006

**M**r. John H. Nelson, age 92, died Wednesday, May 31, 2006 in Nunica. He was born July 24, 1913 in Muskegon to Harry and Wilimonia (Kernigan) Nelson, and had been a life resident. Mr. Nelson was member of First Congregational Church, Vikings Linne 57 Lodge, Muskegon Aerie Eagles, and the Muskegon Moose Lodge.
