Mrs. Dolores Ann Wingett, age 72, passed away early Friday, June 16, 2006. 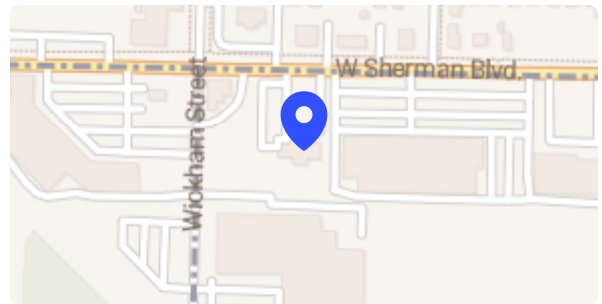

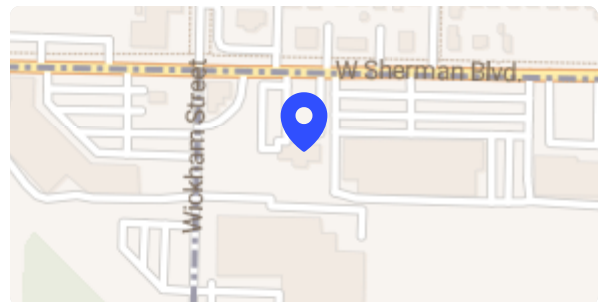
