Mr. Arling H. Jensen, age 90, died Sunday morning, August 20, 2006. He was born May 16, 1916 in Muskegon to Henry & Hannah (Ericksen) Jensen; and had been a life resident of the area. "Arley" served his country during WW II in England and France having been the number one draftee from Muskegon. He was retired in 1946 as a Major in the U.S. Air Force. He had worked at Sealed Power Corporation for 33 years. From 1968 – 1982 he was Vice-President of Sales for Muskegon Piston Ring. "Arley" then joined Dynagear Corporation, of Downers Grover, IL, as Manager of Acquisitions, retiring in 1998. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church and of its Men's Club. He was a life-member of the Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE), where he had served as its Chairman. He was also a member of the Retired Officer's Association, the Muskegon Country Club; and in his leisure time enjoyed golf, boating and fishing. SURVIVORS include his wife of 64 years, the former Evelyn Franklin; 2 children Kay (Michael) Olthoff of Norton Shores and Scott (Sandra) Jensen of Delafield, WI; 6 grandchildren & 2 great-grandchildren, Jason (Jayme) Olthoff and their daughter Sydney, Chris Olthoff, Nancy Olthoff, Betsy (Nathan) Labatt and their daughter Ava, Emily Jensen and Andrew Jensen; and by 1 nephew, Wayne (Marita) Bailey. "Arley" was preceded in death by his sister, Ingebor Webb and nephew, Don Bailey.
