## Virginia D. "Ginny" Horness

DEC 5, 1916 - SEP 17, 2006

**M**rs. Virginia D. "Ginny" Horness, age 89, went home to be with her Lord and Savior, Sunday, September 17, 2006 at a local nursing home. She was born December 5, 1916 in Little Rock, Arkansas to Milton and Lillie (Hayes) Underwood and moved to the Muskegon area in 1939. Ginny had graduated Central Bible College in 1938. She was a member of Calvary Church of Fruitport and had served as an organist and pianist for many years. Ginny also used her ministry in music at several area nursing homes over the years.
