## Patricia "Grace" Grabinski

MAY 12, 1917 - DEC 17, 2007

**M**rs. Patricia "Grace" Grabinski, age 90, passed away Monday, December 17, 2007, at a local nursing home. She was born May 12, 1917 in Muskegon to Joseph and Julia (Mikula) Sladek and lived in the area her entire life. On May 13, 1938, she married Chester Frank Grabinski and he preceded her in death in 1973. Prior to her retirement in 1983, Grace worked 24 years as an inspector for S.D. Warren Paper Mill. Grace was a lifelong member of St. Michael Catholic Church where she was an active member of the Altar Society, the Rosary Society, the Sodality, and the choir. SURVIVORS include her son, Leonard (Nancy) Grabinski of Naples, FL; her daughter, Mary Ann (Randy) Young of Point Sienna, FL; 3 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
