Mr. Louis R. Arcioni, age 80, passed away Wednesday, February 20, 2008. He was born January 30, 1928 in Muskegon to Frank and Zelda (Cuykendall) Arcioni. Mr. Arcioni worked for the Artistic Carten formerly Muskegon Paper Box for 49 years and retired in 1990. Mr. Arcioni has lived in Auburn, Indiana for the past 22 years. He was an avid sportsman and loved to golf, fish and hunt, and also loved spending time with his family. He was a member of Immaculate Conception Church and Knights of Columbus. He was the President of the Aging & Home Services and Senior Heimach Center Auburn, Indiana. On August 14, 1948 he married the former Lillian W.
