Mrs. Catherine S. Fuller, age 86, passed away at her residence Monday afternoon following a long illness. Catherine was born in Muskegon on October 6, 1921 to Isidor and Rose (Wieber) Huss. She married Mr. George Fuller in 1939; he preceded her in death in 2000. Catherine was employed at Muskegon Piston Ring for 28 years, retiring in 1979. She was a life long member of the U.A.W. Local 480, Union Buyers Club and was secretary of the Local 480 retirees. She was a member of St. Francis de Sales Catholic Church, the Catholic Daughters of the Americas and throughout her active life served on many different boards and organizations.
