**M**rs. Drucilla “Dru” Nash, age 81, died Wednesday morning, August 27, 2008. She was born November 2, 1926 in Castle Dale, Utah to Samuel and Atlanta (Berg) Zwahlen and had resided in the Muskegon area since 1950. Mrs. Nash was an LPN for Hackley Hospital for 25 years before retiring in 1988. She was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints on Giles Road. When she wasn’t spending time with her family, she enjoyed cross stitch and needle point, and loved to read. On April 24, 1947 she married Harry J. 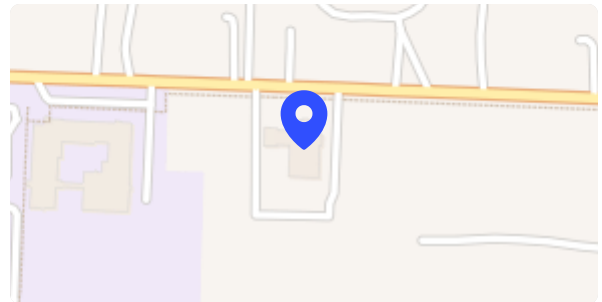
