Mrs. Hoogsteen worked for the Grand Rapids Board of Education, retiring in 1978, and was a member of Calvin Christian Reformed Church in Muskegon. 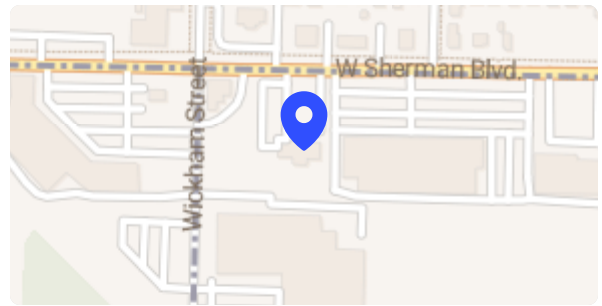
