Mr. Thomas E. Majeski, age 62, passed away Wednesday, December 10, 2008 at his home. He was born November 11, 1946 to William and Florence (Kulesza) Majeski and resided in Muskegon his entire life. Tom was a Veteran of the U.S. Army, having served during Vietnam. He worked as an accountant for International Aid, and previously worked at Eagle Ottawa, Grand Haven Stamp, Clarke Floor Machine and Hardware Distributors. Tom was a member of Calvary Church where he was involved with the Finance Committee and AWANA. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, golfing, drag racing and bowling with the Sherman Commercial League where he was the secretary for 35 years. 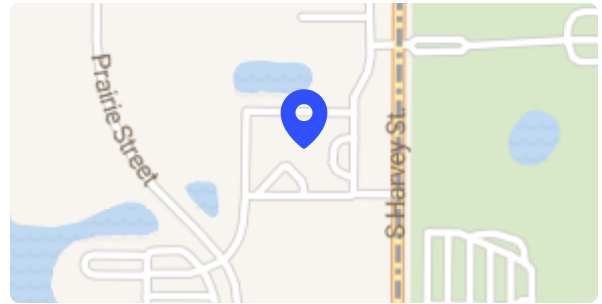
