## Arthur Gustafson

NOV 15, 1924 - MAY 9, 2009

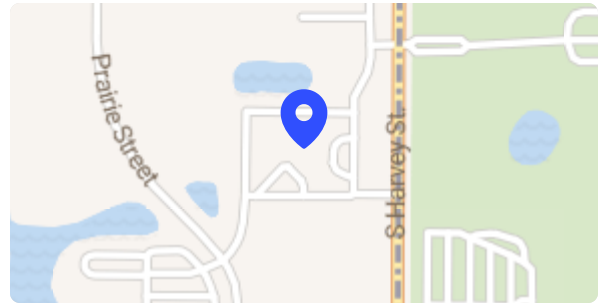
