Mrs. Dolores (La) (Chandonnet) Boucher, age 93, passed away Sunday afternoon, May 31, 2009 in Muskegon. She was born in Muskegon on February 13, 1916 to John and Flora (Langlois) Chandonnet, and lived almost all of her life in this area. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, and the Ladies Altar Society. She had worked on the children's school lunch program for many years as a cook and server, worked as a caterer at weddings and parties, and also enjoyed sewing and crocheting. On June 5, 1937 she married Alvin Boucher, and he preceded her in death on June 25, 2005. 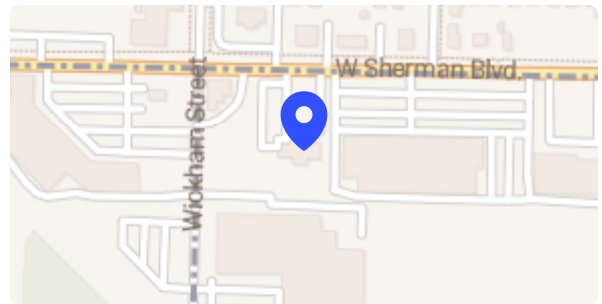

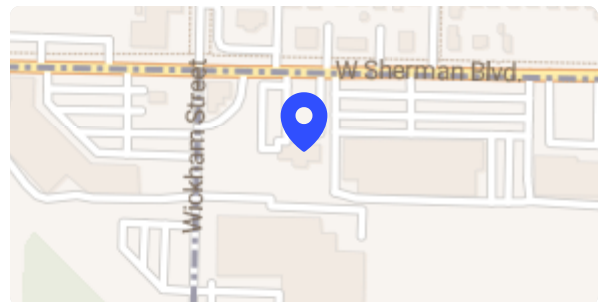
