Mr. Charles H. Landon, Jr., age 89, passed away Sunday morning, June 21, 2009. He was born December 31, 1919 in Branch, MI to Charles H. and Amy (Derby) Landon, Sr. Mr. Landon was a WWII U.S. Army Veteran and was a member of Laketon Bethel Reformed Church. He worked for Teledyne Continental Motors for 37 years before retiring in 1977 and also owned and operated Landon's Excavating for many years.
