Mr. Marvin H. Archer, age 73, died Thursday morning, September 17, 2009 at VNS Hospice House. He was born May 10, 1936 in East Jordan, MI to William & Iva Irene (Bingham) Archer and has resided in the Muskegon area since the age of sixteen. Mr. Archer had been employed at S.D. 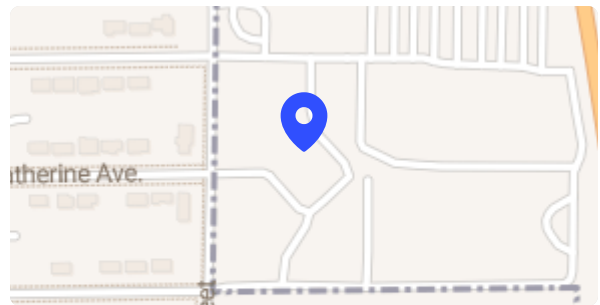
