Mrs. Jean Mary Bancuk, age 85, died Friday morning, November 13, 2009, in Muskegon. Jean had been a teacher at Muskegon Heights and then for Orchard View Schools where she had been employed over 28 years prior to her retirement. 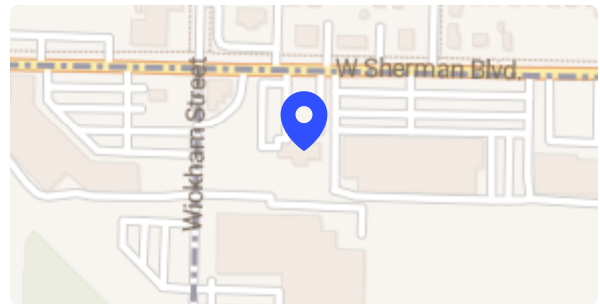
