Mrs. Reta Rose Lorenz, age 72, passed away Tuesday evening, November 17, 2009 in Muskegon. She was born in Flint, MI on January 26, 1937 to John Edward and J. 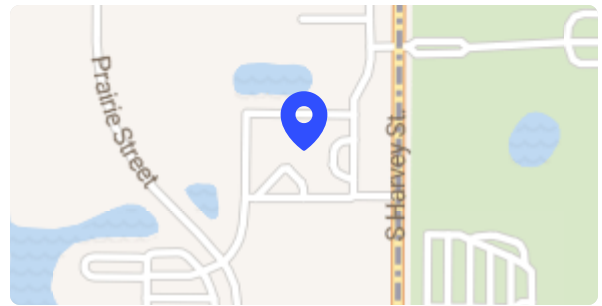
