Mr. Robert N. Robidoux, age 75, died early Sunday morning, December 27, 2009, at his home. Bob retired in 1996 from Brunswick Corporation as a production packer, where he had been employed 44 years. He attended Christian Life Center and enjoyed being an avid hunter and fisherman. 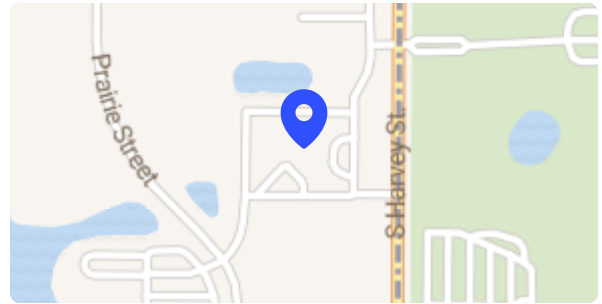

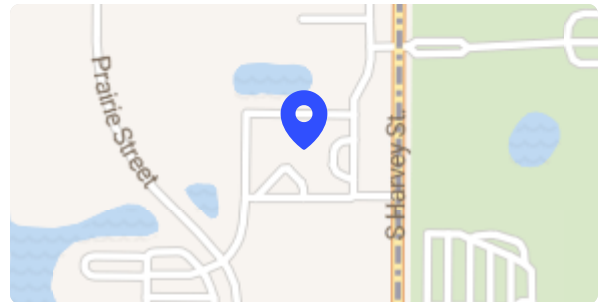
