Mr. Archie L. Johnson, age 86, passed away Sunday evening, January 10, 2010. He was born May 19, 1923 to Albert and Fannie (Sauvola) Johnson in Duluth, MN, and had lived in Muskegon for the past nine years. He married the former Louise M. Abrahamson on Sept. 6, 1947 in Superior, WI, and she survives him. Mr. Johnson had been employed as a design engineer at United States Steel Corp. in Chicago, IL for 33 years, retiring in 1983. He was a former member of Beverly Covenant Church in Chicago, a member of Central United Methodist Church in Muskegon, and was a combat-wounded Army veteran of World War II. His SURVIVORS include his wife, Louise; three sons: Daniel (Renee) Johnson of Hinsdale, IL, Rev. James (Rev. Jan) Johnson of Muskegon, and David (Barbara) Johnson of Portland, OR; seven grandchildren; two brothers: Arnold (Donna) Johnson of Duluth, MN and Donald (Yolanda) Johnson of Branson West, MO; and a sister-in-law, Hazel Johnson of Duluth, MN.
