Eugene R. Scarbrough, age 81, passed away Wednesday afternoon, May 5, 2010. Born Oct. 18, 1928 in Cadillac to John R. and Melvina (Priest) Scarbrough, he was a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Korean Conflict. Mr. Scarbrough retired as a pipefitter at S.D. Warren Co. after more than 30 years there, and was a member of the American Legion. He married the former Oliva Joyce July 11, 1974 in Muskegon, and she died July 27, 2007. SURVIVORS include his children: Patricia (Gary) Garn, Gail (Ted) Pastoor, and Lester (Kathy) Scarbrough; stepchildren Olivia (Dick) Fellows and Sammy Rush; 12 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren; six brothers and two sisters.
