Mrs. Elizabeth E. Turbessi, age 84, passed away Tuesday, June 29, 2010 at her home. She was born November 5, 1925 to Walter and Ethel (Long) West and was a life long resident of the Muskegon area. Following her graduation from Muskegon Heights High School, Elizabeth was employed at Shaw-Walker and maintained friendships with the people she met there.
