Mr. Todd Eric Cioe, age 44, passed away Tuesday morning, October 12, 2010, at Trident Hospital, North Charleston, SC, after a very courageous 15-year battle with brain cancer. Todd was born August 19, 1966, in Muskegon, to David and Jacqueline (Leas) Cioe; and resided in the area until moving to South Carolina four-years ago. Todd had attended Christ Community Church of Spring Lake, was a faithful Detroit Lions fan and had worked in hotel and restaurant management. On October 22, 1994, Todd married the former Kelly L. Simonds and she survives him along with 2 children, Christopher and Kayla Cioe of Goose Creek, SC; his mother and step-father, Jacqueline Cioe and William Braun of Irons, MI; 1 brother, Scott (Kelly) Cioe of Portsmouth, NH; grandfather, Lawrence "Larry" Cioe of Muskegon; aunt and uncle, Mary Lou and Ted Williams of Muskegon; step-mother, Julie Cioe of Grand Rapids; step-brother, Jamie Cioe of Chicago and by his father and mother-in-law, Don and Eva Simonds of Kalamazoo.
