Mr. Edwin A. "Ed" Hodges, Sr., age 80, passed away Thursday evening, March 10, 2011. He was born April 13, 1930 in Elbridge Twp., MI to James and Edna (Fuller) Hodges. Mr. Hodges was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean War, serving 9 years, and spent 5 of those years stationed in Germany. He worked for Morrison Industrial and Equipment Company for 31 years before retiring in 1990. Mr. Hodges was a life-member of the VFW Post #446, former member of the Heights Eagles, and had attended Edgewood Lutheran Church. He loved working on cars and working in his yard. On December 18, 1954 he married the former Carole Anne Larsen in Ludington, MI. 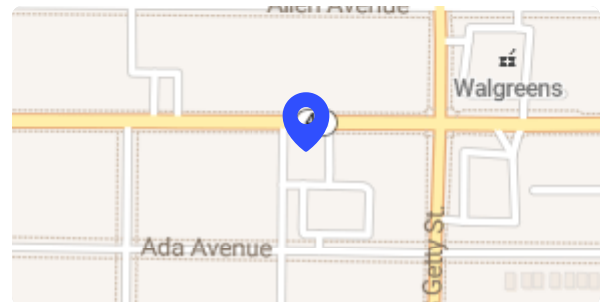
