Mrs. Shirley A. Cleveland, age 75, passed away Wednesday afternoon, March 23, 2011. She was born November 19, 1935 in Chicago, IL to Leon and Pauline (Johnson) Corning. Mrs. Cleveland worked for Muskegon General Hospital for 6 years prior to her 11 year employment at the Muskegon Regional Center. She retired in 1984. Mrs. Cleveland was a member of Evanston Ave. Baptist Church for over 50 years, where she had belonged to the Women's Fellowship, the Prayer Group, and had also been a Sunday school teacher. 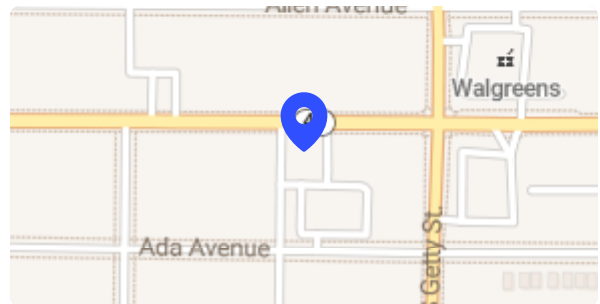
