Mr. Paul L. Peterson, age 84, passed away Thursday, January 26, 2012 in Muskegon. He was born in Cincinnati, OH on February 11, 1927 to Ralph L. and Laura (Laberteaux) Peterson. Mr. Peterson was a veteran of the United States Army having served in Italy during WWII. After his service, he attended Michigan State University where he received a degree in Metallurgical Engineering. Shortly after graduating, he moved to Muskegon and was employed by Sealed Air working locally and in Ohio, Belgium and Mexico. Mr. Peterson was an active member of Central United Methodist Church. He enjoyed golfing, traveling, and woodworking, but most importantly, he loved spending time with his family. On September 18, 1949, Paul married the former Sally A. Burriss in Niles, MI and she survives him along with 5 children, Eric C. (Sandra) Peterson of Holland, MI and their children, Kristin and Matthew (Danielle); Jon P.
