Carol P. Voshel, age 91, of Spring Lake passed away Tuesday, September 6, 2016 at the Leila and Cyrus Poppen Hospice Residence. She was born September 21, 1924, to Hugh and Florence (Potterton) Shirlaw. Carol married Jack J. Voshel on December 15, 1945, in New Jersey. He preceded her in death on February 14, 2013.

Carol attended St. David's Episcopal Church in Englewood, FL. She was a member of the Grand Haven and Grand Rapids Elks, former member of Highlands Country Club in Grand Rapids and Spring Lake Country Club. She also served as secretary for the Tri-Cities Little League for many years, and was on the Board of Directors for Alameda Isles in Englewood, FL. 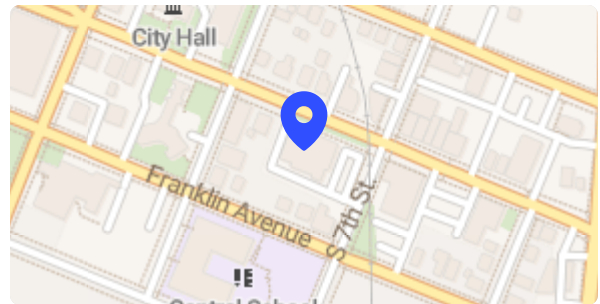

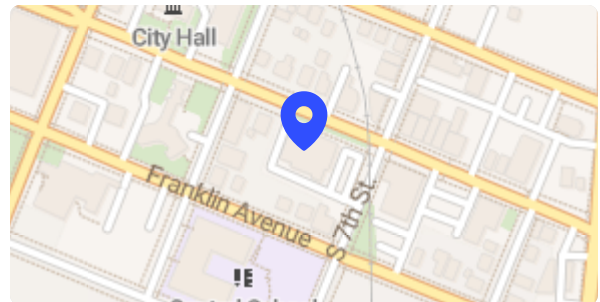
